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## Lot 105. Audemars Piguet — Quantieme Perpetuel, “The Clover”

Audemars Piguet Quantieme Perpetuel, reference 25681BA, is a rare and poetic expression of high horology made between 1988 to 1991. Often referred to by collectors as “The Clover” or “Il Quadrifoglio,” this timepiece is celebrated for its distinctive case design and its role in the revival of mechanical complications.

Another rare Audemars Piguet is Lot 105, the so-called Clover. This model was only made

between 1988–1991 and is appreciated by many for its distinctive design.

The Omega Speedmaster has become an iconic chronograph made in endless different executions. Lot 43 is a so-called Ultraman, with a distinct orange chronograph seconds hand setting it apart from other Speedmasters from its time. This version was made during a very short time and has become a collector favourite. Another interesting Omega is Lot 74, a Marine from 1939. This model was launched in 1932, considered the first commercially available wristwatch made for diving. These are more commonly seen in steel, but this version is made of 9K gold.

This spring’s catalogue consists of 132 lots, as always carefully handpicked to present a varied and interesting selection. We are very happy with the quality and broad diversity we can offer this season and hope you will enjoy browsing the catalogue as much as we have done putting it together.

# Buyer's Guide

All items at the auction are sold as seen. The buyer is therefore advised to carefully examine the condition of the lots before the auction. If Kaplans has made a serious error of judgement, stated any incorrect information, or if a so-called hidden defect exists, this may constitute a basis for cancelling the purchase. Complaints must be made within 10 days after the auction.

Our hammer auctions are physical auctions that are held at our premises at Biblioteksgatan 5 in Stockholm. You can bid online or bid in our auction room during these auctions. You may also submit absentee bids.

## Absentee bids

You may submit absentee bids for any item via Customer Services or our website until the time an auction starts. You indicate your maximum bid, which is the maximum amount you are willing to pay for a given lot. Customer Service then automatically bid on your behalf for this amount.

## Bid online

You can bid online during the auction. Simply log in with your customer number or registered email address and password. You submit your bid by clicking on the "Place bid" button. Your bid is made immediately and in accordance with our bidding intervals. All bids made at our auctions are binding. Kaplans Auktioner cannot guarantee that all bids are received at auction.

## Bidding in our auction hall

To bid in our auction hall during a hammer auction, you need an auction paddle that you obtain from Customer Services either prior to or during an auction. Your bid is binding until another bidder makes a higher bid. The buyer is the bidder who makes the last and highest bid when the auction hammer falls.

If two bidders make a bid of the same value, it is the auctioneer who determines which bid applies. The auctioneer also determines whether bidding should resume due to uncertainty surrounding the last bid.

Estimate prices are also quoted in Euro, where the exchange rate € 1 = SEK 10.80 is used in this catalogue. Amounts are rounded off up or down to the nearest ten. However, the final purchase price is set using the official exchange rate of the day of the auction. Purchased lots shall be paid in Swedish kronor. Purchased lots must be picked up and paid for within 5 business days from the auction date.

## Bidding increments

Bidding starts at the lowest bid and then follow these increments:

Bids are accepted within the bidding increments, however the auctioneer may deviate from these intervals.

## Buyer's premium

Kaplans Auktioner charges a buyer's premium of 20% on hammer prices up to SEK 1 000 000, VAT included. Value added tax is calculated only on Kaplans' sales commission and not on the hammer price. For each item purchased at auction we also charge a hammer fee of SEK 50 including VAT.

## Buyer's premium levels

If the hammer price exceeds SEK 1 000 000, we use the following levels: Hammer price up to SEK 1 000 000: 20% premium. Hammer price between SEK 1 000 000 and SEK 5 000 000: 10% premium. Hammer price above SEK 5 000 000: 5 % on the exceeding part.

## Bidding example:

You have placed a winning bid of SEK 5 500 000 on an item.

Premium:

1 000 000 \* 20 % = SEK 200 000

4 000 000 \* 10 % = SEK 400 000

500 000 \* 5 % = SEK 25 000

Total buyer's premium = SEK 625 000.

The hammer fee is SEK 50.

Total amount: SEK 6 125 050.

# Important Watches – at Kaplans Auktioner

## Selection

The idea of Important Watches is to create an auction which consists primarily of collectibles.

These watches may sometimes have a rather modest price, but somehow appeal to us because they are rare, unique and sometimes in mint condition. Some items may be restoration objects but can still be considered collectibles. We usually offer a couple of newer watches as well, in which case the watches are of more unusual models, with the associated certificate accompanied.

Boxes and certificates are available only when it is stated in the catalogue text.

All watches are sold as seen, both at the auction and in the store. All assessments of damage are subjective, as made by our experts. Buyers should carefully make their own assessment of the object.

The watches sold by Kaplans Auktioner are to be considered as art objects. This means that Kaplans Auktioner cannot guarantee the buyer that the watches work perfectly as timepieces.

Leather straps, gaskets and plastic crystals are considered service parts and may often be necessary to replace.

## Definitions, measurements and grading

“Not working” means that an overhaul of the watch at a watchmaker is necessary. It may concern a new battery, cleaning, new oil, and/or a repair.

“Defect” means that the watch is completely or partially damaged, and thus in a need of repair. It may also need new parts to get in good working condition.

Measurements described in the catalogue indicate the case’s outer dimensions, excluding crown and eventual push buttons.

All items are described with a grading system on a scale from one to ten, where ten is considered to be perfect. The categories that are graded are; movement (M), dial (D), case (C), bracelet (B). The expert’s opinion (EO) is our rating of the watch.

Example from a description of a watch: M 9, D 10, C 8, B 9, EO 9

## We recommend

When buying at an auction, you should expect some service or repair to be needed to get the watch in good condition. In some cases, such a repair and service may be costly. Please ask us before the auction.

Some watches need a battery replacement and all watches need new gaskets or a cleaning periodically.

We recommend an overhaul of the watch at a watchmaker’s at least every fifth to sixth years. For a watch to be waterproof, one should test it every one to two years.

## Tips and advice concerning your watch

Kaplans guarantees the authenticity of the watch and the accuracy of the cataloguing of the item you have purchased. All watches are sold as seen and therefore Kaplans is not responsible for the time accuracy of the watches. It is impossible to know where the current watch is in the service interval. If service documentation is not included you should expect the watch to be in need of an overhaul shortly.

### Service

All watches do have maintenance needs, and you should regularly submit your watch to a watchmaker for overhaul. The overhaul includes cleaning, oil change, new gaskets, etc.

Please note that watchmakers will perform an overhaul in different ways. It may sometimes be difficult to compare prices. We recommend you to always ask for a quote when you submit your watch. This way you know in advance what is to be done, at what cost, and an estimated delivery time. A watch should get an overhaul at an interval of five to six years.

### Time Deviation

The quartz movement is generally resistant to shock and has a good precision. With a quartz movement you can expect a deviation of plus/minus maximum 10 seconds/month.

A mechanical watch (manual or automatic) has more parts and is therefore more sensitive to shocks. It is also influenced by temperature changes and movements, why you need to have a greater tolerance for differences in precision. With a mechanical watch you should expect a deviation of up to plus/minus 3–4 minutes/month.

### Waterproof

The waterproofing ability of a watch is expressed in the following instructions, often indicated on the watch dial:

30 m / 3 ATM / 3 bar

50 m / 5 ATM / 5 bar

100 m / 10 ATM / 10 bar

150 m / 15 ATM / 15 bar

200 m / 20 ATM / 20 bar

A watch is considered to be water resistant if it is marked 30 m. In practice, water resistant means that you may use it as an everyday watch, washing hands, washing dishes and wear it in slight rain.

If you want to be able to shower and swim with your watch, it must be resistant to at least 100 m.

To withstand diving and the stress this causes due to large pressure changes, the watch should at least be resistant to 200 m.

Note that the gaskets are to be seen as service parts and the watch must be maintained to retain its density. Kaplans recommends that you submit your watch to a watchmaker who works with the specific brand, to replace the gaskets and get the watch pressure tested every one to two years, or before a vacation by the seaside.

### Dial

All the objects are described with a grading system, including five categories that assess the condition from one to ten, where ten is considered to be perfect. One of the categories that are considered is the dial.

The damages assessed for a dial may for example include discoloration, moisture damage or some other kind of damage. It is rarely, if ever, that a damaged dial affects the function of the watch. This is a damage of a more cosmetic character.

### Leather Strap

We recommend our customers to buy a new leather strap, because the included strap on a used watch is often worn out. To take care of your newly purchased strap, wipe the band with a slightly damp, soft cloth after use.

### Bracelet

You can clean your watch bracelet yourself using a soft cloth or brush, soap and lukewarm water. However, it is very important to know that the watch is waterproof and has been tested recently so that it doesn't get damaged by moisture during the cleaning. In case of doubt, do not rinse the watch under water.

### Valuation certificate

We are happy to provide a written valuation certificate. Kaplans Auktioner's valuation certificates are recognized by all insurance companies and several of the appraisers who work at Kaplans Auktioner's Watch Department are "of the Swedish Chambers of Commerce appointed appraiser."

In addition to a picture and a clear cataloguing, your watch valuation certificate also contains a current market value. As this value for various reasons may change over time, it is important to renew your valuation certificate regularly. We, and most insurance companies, recommend that you do this after two, maximum three years, or if something remarkable happens to the watch.

## Lot 5. A. Lange & Söhne — Lange 1

A. Lange & Söhne, founded in 1845, revolutionized precision watchmaking, but the production ended in 1948 during World War II. Walter Lange, ancestor of founder Ferdinand, refounded the company in 1990 and their first four new models were released in 1994, one of them the today iconic Lange 1. The watch stands out for its off-centre - but balanced -dial configuration, the oversized date and the high-end in-house movement with its manually engraved balance cock, making every movement a one of a kind.

## Lot 19. Tudor — Black Bay 58 “Platinum Jubilee RaSP”

This model was specially made in a limited edition of 300 pieces for the Royalty and Specialist Protection Unit, commemorating Queen Elizabeth II’s Platinum Jubilee in 2022.

(RaSP) is a specialist unit within the Metropolitan Police Service’s Protection Command. The unit was created in April 2015 through the merger of the former Royalty Protection (SO14) and Specialist Protection (SO1) units. They are responsible for providing protection for individuals who are considered to be at particular risk due to their status or role in society for example the Royal Family, Government Ministers including the Prime Minister and visiting Heads of State.

The dial displays the Royal Tudor Rose and on the case back, “E II R”, of which special permission had to be granted by the Royal household in order to be featured on the watch. Also on the case back is the original owners personal warrant number (personal/service identification number), and the Royal Crown.

## Lot 38. Audemars Piguet — Royal Oak

Unveiled at the Basel Fair in April 1984, Audemars Piguet introduced its first Royal Oak with a perpetual calendar, initially referenced as 5554 and shortly thereafter as 25554. Despite being presented in steel, the only watch completed that year was made in yellow gold.

The project proved technically demanding, as the brand aimed to house the ultra-thin calibre 2120/2800 within the same case profile as the Royal Oak 5402. This required several discreet adjustments, including a modified bezel, a slimmer crystal, and integrated correctors, resulting in a total thickness of just 7.5 mm. Approximately 270 examples of these early references were produced before a redesigned case was introduced in 1987 to improve water resistance.

The present watch is a reference ST25654, part of this updated generation. While retaining the iconic Royal Oak aesthetic, it features a slightly thicker case at 8.3 mm, reflecting the technical refinements made to enhance durability and practicality. The production of reference 25654 continued until 1998.

The Speedmaster “Ultraman” features a distinctive orange chronograph seconds hand, setting it apart from the standard model. It is considered rare because only a few of the ST 145.012 watches were fitted with the orange chronograph hand during a very short time.

## Lot 74. Omega — Marine

The evolution of dive watches is an interesting area. Utilitarian designs rooted in the demands from military, commercial, and later recreational diving. While the Rolex Oyster case famously made its entry in the mid 20ies, Omega launched what is considered the first commercially available wristwatch made for diving in 1932. This rectangular watch with an intricate double case does not look like what we expect a dive watch to look like today. It rather has the appearance and size of a dress watch, with a touch of art deco styling. The design of dive watches was to evolve and include bigger (and luminous) dials and hands, timing devices such as the now classic diving bezel and breakthroughs in gasket and case design. In this lineage the Omega Marine stands out in stark contrast as an early, unique, and historically interesting timepiece.

## Lot 106. Rolex — Day-Date “Bark Finish”

Introduced in the early 1970s, Rolex’s “Bark Finish” is one of those details that really stands out if you know what you’re looking at. Most commonly seen on Day-Date models in yellow or white gold, it was applied to both the bezel and the center links of the President bracelet.

The textured, bark-like surface was created through a hand-applied engraving process, meaning no two examples are exactly alike. It comes from a period when Rolex, somewhat surprisingly, experimented with more expressive and unconventional variations of their otherwise very restrained designs. Today, these bark-finished models are often appreciated precisely for that reason, they represent a slightly more playful and unusual side of Rolex.

## Lot 117. Patek Philippe — Nautilus, Ref. 3800

Produced from the early 1980s until 2006, the Nautilus reference 3800 was introduced as a more compact alternative to the original reference 3700, the first Nautilus model which featured a larger case.

While retaining the unmistakable design language of its original design, the 3800 offered a more versatile 37.5 mm case size. What truly sets it apart, however, is its movement. Unlike the 3700, which relied on a Jaeger LeCoultre base, the 3800 was fitted with Patek Philippe's in house calibre 335 SC. This marked an important step toward greater technical independence for the brand, while also adding a central seconds hand, a subtle but meaningful evolution in everyday functionality.

An often overlooked but intriguing detail on early examples is the use of a white gold folding clasp paired with an otherwise yellow gold case and bracelet, a small inconsistency that adds to the charm and collectability of these watches today.
