# Welcome to Important Watches — Autumn 2022

When vacations are over and the warm summer breeze slowly is turning into crispier autumn air, many people are getting inspired for a new start. This is probably the time we really should be celebrating New Year. It is also the time of year when we at the watch department put in a higher gear to produce the autumn edition of the Important Watches auction and make it as great as it can possibly be. We are very proud of what we can present this time, with everything from outstanding vintage to excellent ladies' watches and modern classics.

Just as at our last Important Watches auction, which happened to be our most successful yet, we have a solid selection of Rolex and Patek Philippe watches. None the less when it comes to Rolex Daytona, where we can present the development of the model, with one from each family of references. Have a closer look at the early Ref. 6239 (Lot 16), Ref. 16520 with Zenith movement and "First Series Dial" (Lot 21), Ref. 116520 with the updated in-house movement (Lot 33) and of course Ref. 116500LN with the black ceramic bezel (Lot 9). In addition to these we are also proud to present Lot 66, a Rolex Oyster Cosmograph Ref. 6234 that collectors have given the nickname "Pre-Daytona". To top it all, we are of course very proud to present not just one, but two, Rolex Daytona s.c. "Paul Newman". Lot 82 with Ref. 6264 and Lot 96 with Ref. 6239.

Another Rolex model that is well-presented at the auction is the GMT-Master, originally designed for pilots who had the need to keep track of time in different time zones. The first one out is Lot 8,

a Ref. 1675 with a "Tropical Gilt Dial", later followed by Ref. 16753 in steel/gold (Lot 43) and Lot 54, a GMT-Master II, Ref. 16760 s.c. "Fat Lady". There's also newer GMT-Masters II, like Lot 11, a "Pepsi" from 2018 and Lot 15 in steel and pink gold from 2020. In summary, something to cater to everyone's taste.

It's not unusual that one great sale of a rare and sought-after model at our auctions generates the chance for us to sell something similar soon again. The stunning Patek Philippe Perpetual Calendar with Ref. 3970 that we sold this spring is one good example. Thanks to a fantastic result that was well noted, we now have the opportunity to present another one of the same reference, but from the fourth and last generation. Make sure you do not miss Lot 5, a classic that will never go out of style.

If you prefer vintage from Patek Philippe, we instead recommend Lots 32 and 88. Lot 32 is the beautiful Ref. 1578 in 18K gold and so called "Spider Lugs", whereas Lot 88 is the very rare Ref. 1504 in steel, originally sold in 1943. Both watches are presented with an "Extract of the Archives".

As usual we're delighted to finally present the complete catalogue, with a total of 103 handpicked watches, all of them with that special something extra.

# Buyer's Guide

All items at the auction are sold as seen. The buyer is therefore advised to carefully examine the condition of the lots before the auction. If Kaplans has made a serious error of judgement, stated any incorrect information, or if a so-called hidden defect exists, this may constitute a basis for cancelling the purchase. Complaints must be made within 10 days after the auction.

Our hammer auctions are physical auctions that are held at our premises at Biblioteksgatan 5 in Stockholm. You can bid online or bid in our auction room during these auctions. You may also submit absentee bids.

## Absentee bids

You may submit absentee bids for any item via Customer Services or our website until the time an auction starts. You indicate your maximum bid, which is the maximum amount you are willing to pay for a given lot. Customer Service then automatically bid on your behalf for this amount.

## Bid online

You can bid online during the auction. Simply log in with your customer number or registered email address and password. You submit your bid by clicking on the "Place bid" button. Your bid is made immediately and in accordance with our bidding intervals. All bids made at our auctions are binding. Kaplans Auktioner cannot guarantee that all bids are received at auction.

## Bidding in our auction hall

To bid in our auction hall during a hammer auction, you need an auction paddle that you obtain from Customer Services either prior to or during an auction. Your bid is binding until another bidder makes a higher bid. The buyer is the bidder who makes the last and highest bid when the auction hammer falls.

If two bidders make a bid of the same value, it is the auctioneer who determines which bid applies. The auctioneer also determines whether bidding should resume due to uncertainty surrounding the last bid.

Estimate prices are also quoted in Euro, where the exchange rate € 1 = SEK 10,90 is used in this catalogue. Amounts are rounded off up or down to the nearest ten. However, the final purchase price is set using the official exchange rate of the day of the auction. Purchased lots shall be paid in Swedish kronor. Purchased lots must be picked up and paid for within 5 business days from the auction date.

## Bidding increments

Bidding starts at the lowest bid and then follow these increments:

Bids are accepted within the bidding increments, however the auctioneer may deviate from these intervals.

## Buyer's premium

Kaplans Auktioner charges the buyer a premium of 20 %, VAT included. For each item purchased at auction we also charge a hammer fee of SEK 50 including VAT.

### Example

You make the winning bid for an item at SEK 10 000.

The amount you pay is calculated in the following way:  
SEK 10 000 + SEK 2 000 + SEK 50 = SEK 12 050.

## Buyer's premium levels

If the price exceeds SEK 200 000, we use the following staircase:

Sales price up to SEK 200 000: 20 %

Sales price between SEK 200 000 – 500 000: 10 % on the excess

Sales price above SEK 500 000: 5 % on the excess

### Premium example:

You have won an item for SEK 750 000

200 000 x 20 % = SEK 40 000

300 000 x 10 % = SEK 30 000

250 000 x 5 % = SEK 12 500

Total buyer's premium = SEK 82 500

The hammer fee is SEK 50

Total amount: SEK 832 550

# Important Watches

## – at Kaplans Auktioner

### Selection

The idea of Important Watches is to create an auction which consists primarily of collectibles.

These watches may sometimes have a rather modest price, but somehow appeal to us because they are rare, unique and sometimes in mint condition. Some items may be restoration objects but can still be considered collectibles. We usually offer a couple of newer watches as well, in which case the watches are of more unusual models, with the associated certificate accompanied.

Boxes and certificates are available only when it is stated in the catalogue text.

All watches are sold as seen, both at the auction and in the store. All assessments of damage are subjective, as made by our experts. Buyers should carefully make their own assessment of the object.

The watches sold by Kaplans Auktioner are to be considered as art objects. This means that Kaplans Auktioner cannot guarantee the buyer that the watches work perfectly as timepieces.

Leather straps, gaskets and plastic crystals are considered service parts and may often be necessary to replace.

### Definitions, measurements and grading

“Not working” means that an overhaul of the watch at a watchmaker is necessary. It may concern a new battery, cleaning, new oil, and/or a repair.

“Defect” means that the watch is completely or partially damaged, and thus in a need of repair. It may also need new parts to get in good working condition.

Measurements described in the catalogue indicate the case’s outer dimensions, excluding crown and eventual push buttons.

All items are described with a grading system on a scale from one to ten, where ten is considered to be perfect. The categories that are graded are; movement (M), dial (D), case (C), bracelet (B). The expert’s opinion (EO) is our rating of the watch.

Example from a description of a watch: M 9, D 10, C 8, B 9, EO 9

### We recommend

When buying at an auction, you should expect some service or repair to be needed to get the watch in good condition. In some cases, such a repair and service may be costly. Please ask us before the auction.

Some watches need a battery replacement and all watches need new gaskets or a cleaning periodically.

We recommend an overhaul of the watch at a watchmaker’s at least every fifth to sixth years. For a watch to be waterproof, one should test it every one to two years.

## Tips and advice concerning your watch

Kaplans guarantees the authenticity of the watch and the accuracy of the cataloguing of the item you have purchased. All watches are sold as seen and therefore Kaplans is not responsible for the time accuracy of the watches. It is impossible to know where the current watch is in the service interval. If service documentation is not included you should expect the watch to be in need of an overhaul shortly.

## Service

All watches do have maintenance needs, and you should regularly submit your watch to a watchmaker for overhaul. The overhaul includes cleaning, oil change, new gaskets, etc.

Please note that watchmakers will perform an overhaul in different ways. It may sometimes be difficult to compare prices. We recommend you to always ask for a quote when you submit your watch. This way you know in advance what is to be done, at what cost, and an estimated delivery time.

A watch should get an overhaul at an interval of five to six years.

## Time Deviation

The quartz movement is generally resistant to shock and has a good precision. With a quartz movement you can expect a deviation of plus/minus maximum 10 seconds/month.

A mechanical watch (manual or automatic) has more parts and is therefore more sensitive to shocks. It is also influenced by temperature changes and movements, why you need to have a greater tolerance for differences in precision. With a mechanical watch you should expect a deviation of up to plus/minus 3–4 minutes/month.

## Waterproof

The waterproofing ability of a watch is expressed in the following instructions, often indicated on the watch dial:

30 m / 3 ATM / 3 bar

50 m / 5 ATM / 5 bar

100 m / 10 ATM / 10 bar

150 m / 15 ATM / 15 bar

200 m / 20 ATM / 20 bar

A watch is considered to be water resistant if it is marked 30 m. In practice, water resistant means that you may use it as an everyday watch, washing hands, washing dishes and wear it in slight rain.

If you want to be able to shower and swim with your watch, it must be resistant to at least 100 m.

To withstand diving and the stress this causes due to large pressure changes, the watch should at least be resistant to 200 m.

Note that the gaskets are to be seen as service parts and the watch must be maintained to retain its density. Kaplans recommends that you submit your watch to a watchmaker who works with the specific brand, to replace the gaskets and get the watch pressure tested every one to two years, or before a vacation by the seaside.

## Dial

All the objects are described with a grading system, including five categories that assess the condition from one to ten, where ten is considered to be perfect. One of the categories that are considered is the dial.

The damages assessed for a dial may for example include discoloration, moisture damage or some other kind of damage. It is rarely, if ever, that a damaged dial affects the function of the watch. This is a damage of a more cosmetic character.

## Leather Strap

We recommend our customers to buy a new leather strap, because the included strap on a used watch is often worn out. To take care of your newly purchased strap, wipe the band with a slightly damp, soft cloth after use.

## Bracelet

You can clean your watch bracelet yourself using a soft cloth or brush, soap and lukewarm water. However, it is very important to know that the watch is waterproof and has been tested recently so that it doesn't get damaged by moisture during the cleaning. In case of doubt, do not rinse the watch under water.

## Valuation certificate

We are happy to provide a written valuation certificate. Kaplans Auktionser's valuation certificates are recognized by all insurance companies and several of the appraisers who work at Kaplans Auktionser's Watch Department are "of the Swedish Chambers of Commerce appointed appraiser."

In addition to a picture and a clear cataloguing, your watch valuation certificate also contains a current market value. As this value for various reasons may change over time, it is important to renew your valuation certificate regularly. We, and most insurance companies, recommend that you do this after two, maximum three years, or if something remarkable happens to the watch.





## Lot 5. Patek Philippe — Perpetual Calendar

Reference 3970 is considered the heir to the legendary and very sought after 2499. This timepiece is a perfect example of Patek Philippe's watchmaking skill, combining a perpetual calendar with a chronograph function. Launched in 1986, 3970 was 1,5 millimetres smaller than its predecessor but featured two more complications; leap year and 24-hours indication.

The 3970 has been made in four different generations. The first one, only made in 100 pieces in 1986, had a snap-on caseback and two-tone dial where the sub-dials were a few shades darker than the rest of the dial. With the second generation the caseback was replaced to a screw-down, and it was also made possible for customers to order it with a crystal caseback. The two-tone dials were now replaced to ones with sub-dials matching the rest of the dial. For the third generation, the feuille (or leaf) hands were replaced with baton hands and the indices updated to match the hands. Lot 5 is from the fourth and last generation which was made between 1994–2004. There are few changes in comparison with the third generation, but it came with a folding clasp instead of a pin buckle.

## Lot 10. Breitling — Crosswind Special

Breitling released a new and larger model in their series Windrider in 1997, the new model was called Crosswind. The Crosswind was meant as a complement to the best-seller Chronomat, which had been released in 1984. In the year 2000, Crosswind Special was added to the collection. It was one millimetre larger than the original Crosswind and had a big date window at 12 o'clock.

The Crosswind Special was in production for a relatively short amount of time and was cancelled already in 2004. Lot 10 is made in 18K gold and the matching 18K gold Pilot bracelet makes it quite rare.





## Lot 16. Rolex — Oyster Cosmograph "Daytona"

Rolex presented the model Daytona in 1963 with the launch of the Ref. 6239. It was their chronograph that at the time was made for motor sport, thence the name Daytona, inspired by the American racetrack with the same name.

This example is one of the earliest versions, with a straight line underneath the word Cosmograph on the dial. The line is an internal marking, meaning that Tritium has been used instead of Radium – which was done during a transitional period right about this time. It makes this watch a little bit more unique and sought after on the market.

## Lot 38. Audemars Piguet — Royal Oak

The story is well known among watch aficionados. In 1972 at the Basel Fair, Audemars Piguet, released the Royal Oak (Ref. 5402), a design created by Gerald Genta. At the time the Swiss watch industry was struggling, faced with the emerging quartz movement watches from Japan. Launching a high-end, high-priced sports watch in steel with a bold design in this climate can only be described as taking a big risk. Nevertheless, as history shows, it proved to be a good decision and the model is considered a true icon.

This particular piece (Ref. 56023SA) is smaller in diameter (36 millimetres) than the above mentioned 1972 release. Maintaining a thin profile, it is an excellent choice for those with smaller wrists or those wishing an easy wearing watch, the intricate bracelet design highlighted in the steel/gold execution.

In 1983, The GMT-Master II Ref. 16760 was released and it looks a lot like its forerunners, but with a new movement that allows the hour hand to be adjusted without disturbing the minute- or seconds hand. This together with the rotatable bezel allows the wearer to position a third time zone.
