Welcome to Important Watches, Spring 2020

The circumstances surrounding this spring's Important Watches auction are somewhat different to previous seasons due to the unprecedented global situation. But as always at Kaplans, we aim to offer you the finest watches and timepieces, as well as high quality service to all our customers whether they are buying or selling. We continually strive to raise the bar in terms of the quality of the items we have at auction, and we hope that you will find our spring 2020 collection as captivating and as appealing as we do.

Tool watches keep being interesting to collectors, and this auction contains both dive, racing and military watches. But we would like to mention the pilot watches this time. We have as many as nine different Rolex GMT-Masters – one of the most iconic pilot watches there is. How about Lot 49, a reference 1675 “Pepsi” from 1968? Or Lot 87, in steel/gold with “Nipple Dial”; Lot 88, a so-called “Fat Lady” with certificate and box; or Lot 97, a so-called “Batgirl” from 2019? The watch belonged to Captain Rune Steinmark, an aviation hero both in World War II and within commercial flights. Make sure you read his fascinating story on our website.

Rolex continues to be one of the bestselling brands and their sports watches are still the most sought after. However, this year it is time to highlight the most classic Rolex watch there is, the Datejust, that celebrates 75 years. Suitably enough, we now have the largest numbers of Datejusts that we have ever had at an Important Watches auction, several of them with rare dials. Have a look at Lot 8 with lacquer dial, Lot 9 with porcelain dial or Lot 92 with a blue Buckley dial.

Buyer's Guide

All items at the auction are sold as seen. The buyer is therefore advised to carefully examine the condition of the lots before the auction. If Kaplans has made a serious error of judgement, stated any incorrect information, or if a so-called hidden defect exists, this may constitute a basis for cancelling the purchase. Complaints must be made within 10 days after the auction.

Our hammer auctions are physical auctions that are held at our premises at Biblioteksgatan 5 in Stockholm. You can bid online or bid in our auction room during these auctions. You may also submit absentee bids.

Absentee bids

You may submit absentee bids for any item via Customer Services or our website until the time an auction starts. You indicate your maximum bid, which is the maximum amount you are willing to pay for a given lot. Customer Service then automatically bid on your behalf for this amount.

Bid online

You can bid online during the auction. Simply log in with your customer number or registered email address and password. You submit your bid by clicking on the "Place bid" button. Your bid is made immediately and in accordance with our bidding intervals. All bids made at our auctions are binding. Kaplans Auktioner cannot guarantee that all bids are received at auction.

Bidding in our auction hall

To bid in our auction hall during a hammer auction, you need an auction paddle that you obtain from Customer Services either prior to or during an auction. Your bid is binding until another bidder makes a higher bid. The buyer is the bidder who makes the last and highest bid when the auction hammer falls.

If two bidders make a bid of the same value, it is the auctioneer who determines which bid applies. The auctioneer also determines whether bidding should resume due to uncertainty surrounding the last bid.

Estimate prices are also quoted in Euro, where the exchange rate € 1 = SEK 11 is used in this catalogue. Amounts are rounded off up or down to the nearest ten. However, the final purchase price is set using the official exchange rate of the day of the auction. Purchased lots shall be paid in Swedish kronor. Purchased lots must be picked up and paid for within 5 business days from the auction date.

Bidding increments

Bidding starts at the lowest bid and then follow these increments:

Bids are accepted within the bidding increments, however the auctioneer may deviate from these intervals.

Buyer's premium

Kaplans Auktioner charges the buyer a premium of 20 %, VAT included. For each item purchased at auction we also charge a hammer fee of SEK 50 including VAT.

Example

You make the winning bid for an item at SEK 10 000.
The amount you pay is calculated in the following way:
SEK 10 000 + SEK 2 000 + SEK 50 = SEK 12 050.

Buyer's premium levels

If the price exceeds SEK 200 000, we use the following staircase:

Sales price up to SEK 200 000: 20 %

Sales price between SEK 200 000 – 500 000: 10 % on the excess

Sales price above SEK 500 000: 5 % on the excess

Premium example:

You have won an item for SEK 750 000

200 000 x 20 % = SEK 40 000

300 000 x 10 % = SEK 30 000

250 000 x 5 % = SEK 12 500

Total buyer's premium = SEK 82 500

The hammer fee is SEK 50

Important Watches – at Kaplans Auktioner

Selection

The idea of Important Watches is to create an auction which consists primarily of collectibles.

These watches may sometimes have a rather modest price, but somehow appeal to us because they are rare, unique and sometimes in mint condition. Some items may be restoration objects but can still be considered collectibles. We usually offer a couple of newer watches as well, in which case the watches are of more unusual models, with the associated certificate accompanied.

Boxes and certificates are available only when it is stated in the catalogue text.

All watches are sold as seen, both at the auction and in the store. All assessments of damage are subjective, as made by our experts. Buyers should carefully make their own assessment of the object.

The watches sold by Kaplans Auktioner are to be considered as art objects. This means that Kaplans Auktioner cannot guarantee the buyer that the watches work perfectly as timepieces.

Leather straps, gaskets and plastic crystals are considered service parts and may often be necessary to replace.

Definitions, measurements and grading

“Not working” means that an overhaul of the watch at a watchmaker is necessary. It may concern a new battery, cleaning, new oil, and/or a repair.

“Defect” means that the watch is completely or partially damaged, and thus in a need of repair. It may also need new parts to get in good working condition.

Measurements described in the catalogue indicate the case’s outer dimensions, excluding crown and eventual push buttons.

All items are described with a grading system on a scale from one to ten, where ten is considered to be perfect. The categories that are graded are; movement (M), dial (D), case (C), bracelet (B). The expert’s opinion (EO) is our rating of the watch.

Example from a description of a watch: M 9, D 10, C 8, B 9, EO 9

We recommend

When buying at an auction, you should expect some service or repair to be needed to get the watch in good condition. In some cases, such a repair and service may be costly. Please ask us before the auction.

Some watches need a battery replacement and all watches need new gaskets or a cleaning periodically.

We recommend an overhaul of the watch at a watchmaker’s at least every fifth to sixth years. For a watch to be waterproof, one should test it every one to two years.

Tips and advice concerning your watch

Kaplans guarantees the authenticity of the watch and the accuracy of the cataloguing of the item you have purchased. All watches are sold as seen and therefore Kaplans is not responsible for the time accuracy of the watches. It is impossible to know where the current watch is in the service interval. If service documentation is not included you should expect the watch to be in need of an overhaul shortly.

Service

All watches do have maintenance needs, and you should regularly submit your watch to a watchmaker for overhaul. The overhaul includes cleaning, oil change, new gaskets, etc.

Please note that watchmakers will perform an overhaul in different ways. It may sometimes be difficult to compare prices. We recommend you to always ask for a quote when you submit your watch. This way you know in advance what is to be done, at what cost, and an estimated delivery time.

A watch should get an overhaul at an interval of five to six years.

Time Deviation

The quartz movement is generally resistant to shock and has a good precision. With a quartz movement you can expect a deviation of plus/minus maximum 10 seconds/month.

A mechanical watch (manual or automatic) has more parts and is therefore more sensitive to shocks. It is also influenced by temperature changes and movements, why you need to have a greater tolerance for differences in precision. With a mechanical watch you should expect a deviation of up to plus/minus 3–4 minutes/month.

Waterproof

The waterproofing ability of a watch is expressed in the following instructions, often indicated on the watch dial:

30 m / 3 ATM / 3 bar

50 m / 5 ATM / 5 bar

100 m / 10 ATM / 10 bar

150 m / 15 ATM / 15 bar

200 m / 20 ATM / 20 bar

A watch is considered to be water resistant if it is marked 30 m. In practice, water resistant means that you may use it as an everyday watch, washing hands, washing dishes and wear it in slight rain.

If you want to be able to shower and swim with your watch, it must be resistant to at least 100 m.

To withstand diving and the stress this causes due to large pressure changes, the watch should at least be resistant to 200 m.

Note that the gaskets are to be seen as service parts and the watch must be maintained to retain its density. Kaplans recommends that you submit your watch to a watchmaker who works with the specific brand, to replace the gaskets and get the watch pressure tested every one to two years, or before a vacation by the seaside.

Dial

All the objects are described with a grading system, including five categories that assess the condition from one to ten, where ten is considered to be perfect. One of the categories that are considered is the dial.

The damages assessed for a dial may for example include discoloration, moisture damage or some other kind of damage. It is rarely, if ever, that a damaged dial affects the function of the watch. This is a damage of a more cosmetic character.

Leather Strap

We recommend our customers to buy a new leather strap, because the included strap on a used watch is often worn out. To take care of your newly purchased strap, wipe the band with a slightly damp, soft cloth after use.

Bracelet

You can clean your watch bracelet yourself using a soft cloth or brush, soap and lukewarm water. However, it is very important to know that the watch is waterproof and has been tested recently so that it doesn't get damaged by moisture during the cleaning. In case of doubt, do not rinse the watch under water.

Valuation certificate

We are happy to provide a written valuation certificate. Kaplans Auktionser's valuation certificates are recognized by all insurance companies and several of the appraisers who work at Kaplans Auktionser's Watch Department are "of the Swedish Chambers of Commerce appointed appraiser."

In addition to a picture and a clear cataloguing, your watch valuation certificate also contains a current market value. As this value for various reasons may change over time, it is important to renew your valuation certificate regularly. We, and most insurance companies, recommend that you do this after two, maximum three years, or if something remarkable happens to the watch.



Lot 6. Omega—Seamaster 300 “Royal Navy”

The Seamaster 300 is in its own right a sought after vintage watch. This version of the watch, modified according to Military Specifications and issued to the British Military, becomes even more collectible. It features “Mil Spec” design elements such as the “Sword hands”, “T-dial”, minute markers on the diving bezel, fixed spring bars and of course the engraved case back. The watch also comes with a vintage NATO-strap, a design used by military divers that allows easy length adjustment when worn outside a diving suit. Combined with the fixed spring bars it also provides security not to lose the watch during diving activities.

Lot 8, 9. Rolex—Datejust

Hans Wilsdorf and Alfred Davis founded “Wilsdorf & Davis” in 1905, a company that would grow and become what today is Rolex S.A. They celebrated their 40th anniversary in 1945 with a big celebration at Hotel des Bergues in Geneva, and the release of a new model, the Rolex Datejust. This was the first wristwatch with an automatically changing date window, a complication taken for granted today, but a big revolution in the 1940’s. This year we celebrate the 75th anniversary of the Rolex Datejust, a model that is still as classic and popular as ever, available in many variations. Lot 8 and 9 are both in steel with Jubilee bracelet, both with quite unusual dials. Lot 8 with Lacquer Dial and lot 9 with Porcelain Dial.

Lot 26. Omega—Speedmaster Professional “CB Case”

The “Speedy Pro” is one of the most iconic watch designs ever made, and the ST 105.012 reference is important historically for several reasons. It was the first Speedmaster with the word “Professional” on the dial and the first one with a case design providing partial protection for the crown and pushers. As for the ST 105.012-66 in particular, Omega interestingly used two case manufacturers, Huguenin Frères (“HF”) and La Centrale Boîtes (“CB”). There are slight differences in design between the two and the “CB” case can be easily spotted by the facet on top of the curvature of the lyre lugs. The ST 015.012-66 also features the “single step” case back.

Lot 44. Universal—Polarouter “SAS Dial”

In the beginning of the 1950's commercial flights became more common, and the Scandinavian airline SAS (Scandinavian Airlines System) was not late to follow the trend with longer flights. Their new route went from Copenhagen, over the North Pole, to Los Angeles. This was in 1954 and Universal Genève provided the pilots and flight crew with their new watch “Polarouter”. The name was a mixture of the words “Polar” and “Route”, but was renamed to “Polarouter” the year after. Lot 44 was owned by Captain Rune Steinmark, an aviation hero that during his lifetime both worked as a courier aviator during World War II and managed to land a commercial airplane that had lost one of its engines – without anyone being injured. Lot 51. Rolex—Oyster Cosmograph Daytona

Rolex launched an elegant chronograph in 1955 and after making a few adjustments, the Cosmograph (reference 6239) was released in 1963. This was the first time Rolex had the Tachymetre scale on the outside of the crystal and this model is considered the first Daytona. The production went on to 1987, when the new five-digit reference Daytona arrived with an automatic movement. This particular example is the reference 6263 that came in 1971 and was produced until the end in 1987. Today the old manual Daytona is one of the most sought after, collectable watch models that you can find in auctions all around the world.
