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Lot 65. Audemars Piguet — Remaster

Introduced in 2020, the Audemars Piguet [Re]Master01 is a limited edition of 500 pieces that pays tribute to a rare chronograph from 1943. The original model, with its two-tone steel and pink gold case, teardrop lugs, and striking champagne dial, was a bold design for its time—and only a handful were ever produced.

The [Re]Master01 reimagines this vintage aesthetic in a modern way, maintaining the unique case design and Art Deco typography but with the benefits of modern watch making.

Kaplans and its watch department are more than proud to present this season's Important Watches auction. We can offer a varied selection of sought after pieces, with everything from a rare pocket watch with minute repeater (Lot 119), beautiful vintage dress watches and trendy neo-vintage pieces to new sports watches. As always, there is something for everyone.

One section we believe will be very popular are the vintage chronographs from well-renowned brands. We are happy to present Lot 79, a Universal Genève Compax, so called "Nina Rindt", Lot 87, a Breitling Co-Pilot AVI so called "Raquel Welch" and Lot 100, the early Rolex Oyster Chronograph "Monoblocco". All of these are sought after pieces full of vintage charm.

Patek Philippe is well-known for their elegant Calatrava, a dress watch that has been produced in many different versions and in different materials since it was first presented in 1932. If that is what you are searching for, we have Lot 66, double signed and from 1962, Lot 46, a "Last Edition" of the popular reference 3919 from circa 2006 and Lot 106 in platinum with the characteristic diamond in the case at 6 o'clock.

One of the most popular and recognised models from Patek Philippe though is probably the Nautilus. Except for the extravagant Lot 37, reference 5980 in 18 carat pink gold, we have the more unusual Lot 2, reference 3710 with a "Jumbo Case" and power reserve and Lot 7, a tiny two-tone 27 mm version with a diamond bezel.

In the last few years we have experienced more and more people being fascinated with full gold watches, which can be a bold statement and way to show your personality. A few of our favourites from this auction are Lot 69, a Rolex GMT-Master with a Jubilee bracelet and so called "Nipple Dial", Lot 39, a Breitling Crosswind from the late 1990's, Lot 23, an Omega Constellation with a beautiful Lapis Lazuli Dial and Lot 68, Audemars Piguet Royal Oak in pink gold with a diamond bezel.

These are only a few of the many rare and remarkable pieces in this auction's line-up. We hope you will enjoy browsing the catalogue as much as we have done putting it together.

Buyer's Guide

All items at the auction are sold as seen. The buyer is therefore advised to carefully examine the condition of the lots before the auction. If Kaplans has made a serious error of judgement, stated any incorrect information, or if a so-called hidden defect exists, this may constitute a basis for cancelling the purchase. Complaints must be made within 10 days after the auction.

Our hammer auctions are physical auctions that are held at our premises at Biblioteksgatan 5 in Stockholm. You can bid online or bid in our auction room during these auctions. You may also submit absentee bids.

Absentee bids

You may submit absentee bids for any item via Customer Services or our website until the time an auction starts. You indicate your maximum bid, which is the maximum amount you are willing to pay for a given lot. Customer Service then automatically bid on your behalf for this amount.

Bid online

You can bid online during the auction. Simply log in with your customer number or registered email address and password. You submit your bid by clicking on the "Place bid" button. Your bid is made immediately and in accordance with our bidding intervals. All bids made at our auctions are binding. Kaplans Auktioner cannot guarantee that all bids are received at auction.

Bidding in our auction hall

To bid in our auction hall during a hammer auction, you need an auction paddle that you obtain from Customer Services either prior to or during an auction. Your bid is binding until another bidder makes a higher bid. The buyer is the bidder who makes the last and highest bid when the auction hammer falls.

If two bidders make a bid of the same value, it is the auctioneer who determines which bid applies. The auctioneer also determines whether bidding should resume due to uncertainty surrounding the last bid.

Estimate prices are also quoted in Euro, where the exchange rate € 1 = SEK 11.00 is used in this catalogue. Amounts are rounded off up or down to the nearest ten. However, the final purchase price is set using the official exchange rate of the day of the auction. Purchased lots shall be paid in Swedish kronor. Purchased lots must be picked up and paid for within 5 business days from the auction date.

Bidding increments

Bidding starts at the lowest bid and then follow these increments:

Bids are accepted within the bidding increments, however the auctioneer may deviate from these intervals.

Buyer's premium

Kaplans Auktioner charges a buyer's premium of 20% on hammer prices up to SEK 1 000 000, VAT included. Value added tax is calculated only on Kaplans' sales commission and not on the hammer price. For each item purchased at auction we also charge a hammer fee of SEK 50 including VAT.

Buyer's premium levels

If the hammer price exceeds SEK 1 000 000, we use the following levels: Hammer price up to SEK 1 000 000: 20% premium. Hammer price between SEK 1 000 000 and SEK 5 000 000: 10% premium. Hammer price above SEK 5 000 000: 5 % on the exceeding part.

Bidding example:

You have placed a winning bid of SEK 5 500 000 on an item.

Premium:

1 000 000 * 20 % = SEK 200 000

4 000 000 * 10 % = SEK 400 000

500 000 * 5 % = SEK 25 000

Total buyer's premium = SEK 625 000.

The hammer fee is SEK 50.

Total amount: SEK 6 125 050.

Important Watches – at Kaplans Auktioner

Selection

The idea of Important Watches is to create an auction which consists primarily of collectibles.

These watches may sometimes have a rather modest price, but somehow appeal to us because they are rare, unique and sometimes in mint condition. Some items may be restoration objects but can still be considered collectibles. We usually offer a couple of newer watches as well, in which case the watches are of more unusual models, with the associated certificate accompanied.

Boxes and certificates are available only when it is stated in the catalogue text.

All watches are sold as seen, both at the auction and in the store. All assessments of damage are subjective, as made by our experts. Buyers should carefully make their own assessment of the object.

The watches sold by Kaplans Auktioner are to be considered as art objects. This means that Kaplans Auktioner cannot guarantee the buyer that the watches work perfectly as timepieces.

Leather straps, gaskets and plastic crystals are considered service parts and may often be necessary to replace.

Definitions, measurements and grading

“Not working” means that an overhaul of the watch at a watchmaker is necessary. It may concern a new battery, cleaning, new oil, and/or a repair.

“Defect” means that the watch is completely or partially damaged, and thus in a need of repair. It may also need new parts to get in good working condition.

Measurements described in the catalogue indicate the case's outer dimensions, excluding crown and eventual push buttons.

All items are described with a grading system on a scale from one to ten, where ten is considered to be perfect. The categories that are graded are; movement (M), dial (D), case (C), bracelet (B). The expert's opinion (EO) is our rating of the watch.

Example from a description of a watch: M 9, D 10, C 8, B 9, EO 9

We recommend

When buying at an auction, you should expect some service or repair to be needed to get the watch in good condition. In some cases, such a repair and service may be costly. Please ask us before the auction.

Some watches need a battery replacement and all watches need new gaskets or a cleaning periodically.

We recommend an overhaul of the watch at a watchmaker's at least every fifth to sixth years. For a watch to be waterproof, one should test it every one to two years.

Tips and advice concerning your watch

Kaplans guarantees the authenticity of the watch and the accuracy of the cataloguing of the item you have purchased. All watches are sold as seen and therefore Kaplans is not responsible for the time accuracy of the watches. It is impossible to know where the current watch is in the service interval. If service documentation is not included you should expect the watch to be in need of an overhaul shortly.

Service

All watches do have maintenance needs, and you should regularly submit your watch to a watchmaker for overhaul. The overhaul includes cleaning, oil change, new gaskets, etc.

Please note that watchmakers will perform an overhaul in different ways. It may sometimes be difficult to compare prices. We recommend you to always ask for a quote when you submit your watch. This way you know in advance what is to be done, at what cost, and an estimated delivery time. A watch should get an overhaul at an interval of five to six years.

Time Deviation

The quartz movement is generally resistant to shock and has a good precision. With a quartz movement you can expect a deviation of plus/minus maximum 10 seconds/month.

A mechanical watch (manual or automatic) has more parts and is therefore more sensitive to shocks. It is also influenced by temperature changes and movements, why you need to have a greater tolerance for differences in precision. With a mechanical watch you should expect a deviation of up to plus/minus 3–4 minutes/month.

Waterproof

The waterproofing ability of a watch is expressed in the following instructions, often indicated on the watch dial:

30 m / 3 ATM / 3 bar

50 m / 5 ATM / 5 bar

100 m / 10 ATM / 10 bar

150 m / 15 ATM / 15 bar

200 m / 20 ATM / 20 bar

A watch is considered to be water resistant if it is marked 30 m. In practice, water resistant means that you may use it as an everyday watch, washing hands, washing dishes and wear it in slight rain. If you want to be able to shower and swim with your watch, it must be resistant to at least 100 m.

To withstand diving and the stress this causes due to large pressure changes, the watch should at least be resistant to 200 m.

Note that the gaskets are to be seen as service parts and the watch must be maintained to retain its density. Kaplans recommends that you submit your watch to a watchmaker who works with the specific brand, to replace the gaskets and get the watch pressure tested every one to two years, or before a vacation by the seaside.

Dial

All the objects are described with a grading system, including five categories that assess the condition from one to ten, where ten is considered to be perfect. One of the categories that are considered is the dial.

The damages assessed for a dial may for example include discoloration, moisture damage or some other kind of damage. It is rarely, if ever, that a damaged dial affects the function of the watch. This is a damage of a more cosmetic character.

Leather Strap

We recommend our customers to buy a new leather strap, because the included strap on a used watch is often worn out. To take care of your newly purchased strap, wipe the band with a slightly damp, soft cloth after use.

Bracelet

You can clean your watch bracelet yourself using a soft cloth or brush, soap and lukewarm water. However, it is very important to know that the watch is waterproof and has been tested recently so that it doesn't get damaged by moisture during the cleaning. In case of doubt, do not rinse the watch under water.

Valuation certificate

We are happy to provide a written valuation certificate. Kaplans Auktioner's valuation certificates are recognized by all insurance companies and several of the appraisers who work at Kaplans Auktioner's Watch Department are "of the Swedish Chambers of Commerce appointed appraiser."

In addition to a picture and a clear cataloguing, your watch valuation certificate also contains a current market value. As this value for various reasons may change over time, it is important to renew your valuation certificate regularly. We, and most insurance companies, recommend that you do this after two, maximum three years, or if something remarkable happens to the watch.

Lot 2. Patek Philippe — Nautilus, "Power Reserve"

In 1998 the Nautilus Ref. 3710/1A-001 was presented to the watch world. It meant a return to the "Jumbo" case size of the original Nautilus model (Ref. 3700), in contrast to other iterations of the Nautilus in production during this time. While instantly recognisable as a Nautilus, the 3710 shows a slightly different flavour in design. The applied roman indices, the asymmetrically placed power reserve, and the following rearrangement of the brand name to the bottom part of the dial brings out a certain playfulness. It is beautifully balanced using a flat matte black dial.

Be sure to read the letter from the previous owner, an account of the everlasting nature of Patek Philippe and their designs.

Lot 4. Chopard — L.U.C 1860

Chopard began developing their first in-house movement, caliber 1.96, in the early 1990's. The first 20 prototypes were finished in December 1995, and in 1997 it could finally be presented in their new model L.U.C. 1860.

The new movement received a lot of attention and was praised by watch enthusiasts worldwide, it later came to be acknowledged as one of the best movements manufactured in Switzerland. The movement was COSC certified and with Geneva Seal.

The first series of the L.U.C 1860 were divided in three different references and then made in four different precious materials; yellow gold, rose gold, white gold and platinum. All of these were made in limited series and only between 1997–2002.

Lot 29. Breitling — Chronomat “AOPA Logo – First Series”

In the early 1980's, Ernst Schneider who was at the helm of Breitling, found out that the Italian Freccie Tricolori Jet Team was looking for a new chronograph for their pilots. Schneider didn't want to just offer a special version of an existing model; he wanted to create something brand new, and in 1983 the chronograph “Freccie Tricolori” was introduced to the Jet team.

In 1984 Breitling celebrated their 100th anniversary and with that they wanted to launch a new watch that would revolutionize the industry – this in a time when the trend was mostly about slim quartz watches. The new Chronomat was developed based on the “Freccie Tricolori”, keeping signature features like the riders and the now iconic Rouleaux bracelet.

Lot 29 is an early version of the Chronomat reference 81950, bearing the AOPA logo (Aircraft Owners and Pilots Association) on the dial.

The watch model has with time gotten the nickname “Nina Rindt” from its carrier, just like some other legendary racing chronographs from the same era, for example “Jo Siffert”, “Paul Newman” and “Jochen Rindt”.

Jochen Rindt tragically died only a few years after the wedding, during practice for the Italian Grand Prix at Monza. He had a great season before the crash and won five out of the first nine races. Because Jochen had such point advantage, it was enough for a total win that year. He is the only one in racing history that has received the title World Champion posthumously.

In 1963 Breitling launched the Co-Pilot with black dial and white/silver sub-dials. Later on, it got the nickname “Raquel Welch” after being worn by the actress when she played the skydiving character Fathom Harvill in the movie “Fathom” in 1967. The Co-Pilot was not only used by pilots in cockpits anymore but kept being seen also on famous sportsmen like racing driver Ken Miles and ski champion Jean-Claude Killy.
