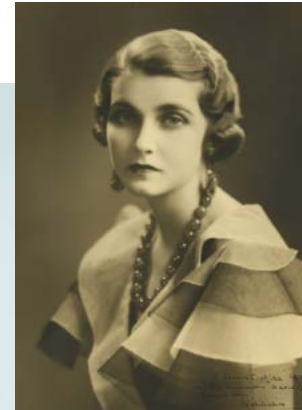

Cartier ring | BARBARA HUTTON

Magnificent Cartier Art Deco ring with
provenance from Barbara Hutton



Barbara Hutton (1912-1979)

“This ring has never been put up
for sale before, which makes
this auction particularly exciting,”
says Stefan Gustavsson,
Head of Jewellery Department.

Barbara Hutton lived an eventful life at the heart of American high society. As the granddaughter of the Woolworth founder, she inherited one of America’s largest fortunes. During her lifetime, she amassed one of the most impressive jewellery collections ever seen.

Hutton was known for her elegant taste and fondness for diamonds, which can be seen in Lot 6 in Important Jewellery.

The Cartier Art Deco ring is made from carved rock crystal, covered in platinum and sprinkled with sparkling diamonds.

The ring was given as a gift to Hutton’s physiotherapist Karin Gustafson on a trip to Egypt in 1935. Gustafson explained how she obtained the ring in a letter she wrote home to Sweden.

Cartier: the jeweller of kings and the king of jewellers

Cartier is one of the world's most prestigious and renowned jewellery brands with a long history of making classic and elegant jewels and watches. Today's celebrated fashion and jewellery design house was founded in Paris in 1847 by jeweller apprentice Louis-François Cartier and was synonymous with high quality, exclusive design and precious materials from the very beginning. With the company thriving, King Edward VII awarded a royal warrant to Cartier in 1904. Cartier's reputation for excellence and creativity soon made it one of the most sought-after jewellery brands in the world, with customers including international film stars and celebrities approaching Cartier to have their pieces made. One of Cartier's many distinguished clients was American heiress Barbara Hutton whose magnificent diamond dome ring from 1930s, which is Lot 6 in this not-to-be-missed auction.

Today, modern-day royalty and celebrities alike are often seen wearing the French jeweller's creations on and off the red carpet, happily posing with one of Cartier's iconic designs like Love Bracelet and Juste un Clou.



Lot 6 comes with a Letter of Expertise, signed by IAJA on 28 March 2023, confirming that the ring is a genuine Cartier item.



The Letter

18 FEB 35 Cairo

Dearest aunt Malin

I have to write a few lines to aunt and tell about my escapades. Have now been here for two weeks but we leave Monday night for Jerusalem, how long we stay there I do not know, afterwards we will head to Damascus. Will be back here on the 2nd of March and then on the 7th of March the Prince will arrive.

Then around the 15-20th of March we are meant to return to America with an Italian steamer. From what I understand when we are back to America, she will file for divorce for her other half. We have had an interesting trip but the most interesting will be to see Jerusalem, it brings me immense sence of joy. Have experienced a camel caravan and camped two nights in the desert. Spoke to Anna on the telephone from London, Miss Barbara paid the bill, she said when she heard that I was going to call, talk for really long and let the bill come to me. Welcome to Important Jewellery

For spring 2023, Kaplans Jewellery Department have the pleasure to showcase a unique selection of fascinating jewellery and silver items. We are delighted to present 120 lots of exquisite jewellery, all in their own way unique.

The premier highlight from this sale is Lot 6, an Art Deco Cartier ring with provenance from Barbara Hutton. The ring is a magnificent work made from carved rock crystal covered in platinum and sprinkled with sparkling diamonds. It was given as a gift by Barbara Hutton from her private collection to her Swedish physiotherapist Karin Gustafson during a trip to Egypt in 1935.

Besides this unique piece, the auction also includes even more iconic jewellery from Cartier and other prominent jewellery brands such as Van Cleef & Arpels, Tiffany & Co., Chanel and Dior. For example, Lot 105 is a stunning diamond pavé-set Juste un Clou-bracelet in 18K gold by Cartier. From Van Cleef & Arpels, we can present Lot 16, a necklace that can be divided into four strands of 18 cm and worn either as a necklace or bracelets, made in 18K gold with chalcedony and 240 brilliant cut diamonds.

The beauty and rarity of Lot 11, a pair of antique cushion-cut Kashmir Sapphires 10.23 ctw, is beyond compare. With no indications of heating and accompanied by certificates from the SSEF Swiss Gemmological Institute and the Gübelin Gem Lab stating that the sapphire is of Kashmir origin, this lot is a rare opportunity on the Swedish market. Lot 17 is a vintage ring from 1947 by David Andersen, incorporating a beautiful blue sapphire of 22.00 ct set in a chunky 18K gold ring.

Of course, the auction features a wide range of period jewellery from the nineteenth century all the way through to the modern designs of today. Lot 49 is a delicate Art Deco platinum and topaz ring, approximately 4.50 ct, designed by Alexander Tillander. Lot 3, “The Flowering Wall” is an 18K gold necklace with tourmalines by Lapponia 1972.

We hope you will find this collection as appealing and inspiring as we do, and we wish you all a warm welcome to participate in this spring’s Important Jewellery on Saturday 3 June.

Buyer's Guide

All items at the auction are sold as viewed. The buyer is therefore advised to carefully examine the condition of the lots before the auction. If Kaplans has made a serious error of judgment, stated any incorrect information, or a so-called hidden defect exists, this may constitute a basis for cancelling the purchase. Complaints must be made within 10 days after the auction.

Our hammer auctions are held at our premises at Biblioteksgatan 5 in Stockholm. You can bid online or bid in our auction room during these auctions. You may also submit absentee bids.

Absentee bids

You may submit absentee bids for any item via Customer Services or our website until the time an auction starts. You indicate your maximum bid, which is the maximum amount you are willing to pay for a given lot. Customer Service then automatically bid on your behalf for this amount.

Bid online

You can bid online during the auction. Simply log in with your customer number or registered email and password. You submit your bid by clicking on the "Place bid" button. Your bid is made immediately and in accordance with our bidding intervals. All bids made at our auctions are binding. Kaplans Auktioner cannot guarantee that all bids are received at auction.

Bidding in our auction hall

To bid in our auction hall during a hammer auction, you need an auction paddle that you obtain from Customer Services either prior to or during an auction. Your bid is binding until another bidder makes a higher bid. The buyer is the bidder who makes the last and highest bid when the auction hammer falls.

If two bidders make a bid of the same value, it is the auctioneer who determines which bid applies. The auctioneer also determines whether bidding should resume due to uncertainty surrounding the last bid.

Estimate prices are also quoted in Euro, where the exchange rate € 1 = SEK 11.20 is used in this catalogue. Amounts are rounded off up or down to the nearest ten. However, the final purchase price is set in Swedish kronor using the official exchange rate upon the day when the payment is made. All purchased lots shall be paid in Swedish kronor.

After the auction

Purchased lots must be picked up and paid for within 5 business days from the auction date. Kaplans accepts payment by credit card. Payment by credit card may be made online or at Customer Services desk. Payments by cash can not exceed SEK 50 000 due to general policy.

Bids are accepted within the bidding increments, however the auctioneer may deviate from these intervals.

Buyer's premium

Kaplans Auktioner charges a buyer's premium of 20% on hammer prices up to SEK 200 000, VAT included. Value added tax is calculated only on Kaplans' sales commission and not on the hammer price. For each item purchased at auction we also charge a hammer fee of SEK 50 including VAT.

Buyer's premium levels

If the hammer price exceeds SEK 200 000, we use the following levels: Hammer price up to SEK 200 000: 20% premium. Hammer price between SEK 200 000 and SEK 500 000: 10% premium on the amount between SEK 200 000 and SEK 500 000. Hammer price above SEK 500 000: 5% premium on the amount above SEK 500 000.

Droit de suite

Under Swedish law Droit de suite, or Artists' Resale Right means that an artist has the right to receive a part of the resale price of their work. The premium is 5% and is paid by the buyer on the condition that the price exceeds SEK 2 415. Items that are covered by Droit de suite is marked with the letter (d) at the end of the item descriptions.

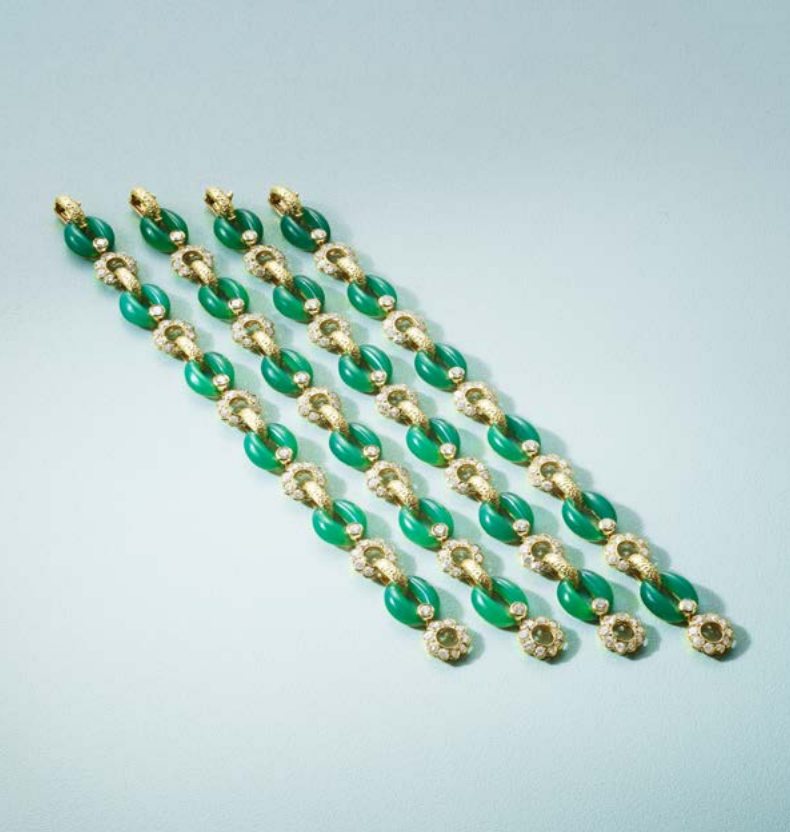

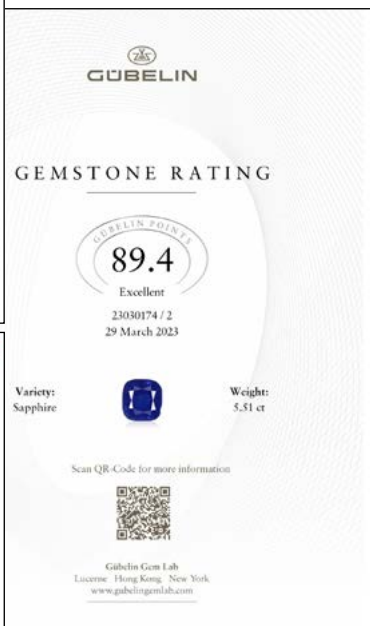
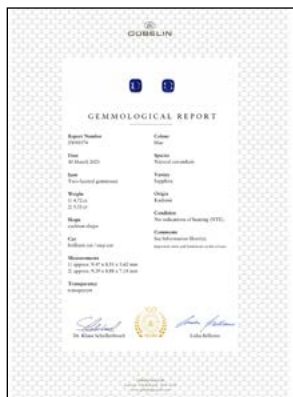
Some of the world finest sapphires originates from Kashmir, located at the northern tip of India. Amidst the Himalayan mountains between Pakistan and China, in the Padar region of Kashmir, which is home to one of the greatest gemstone finds in the world: the sapphires of Kashmir.

Sapphires are minerals formed deep in the earth, under specific geologic conditions of high pressures and temperatures. A delicate balance of the right chemical elements is required to

supply the growing crystal with the ingredients that finally lend it an appealing blue colour.

Fine Kashmiri sapphires display a blue colour that is both deeply saturated and bright at the same time, paired with an incomparable softness: a gentle, diffused light that glows throughout the crystal. (Source: gubelingemlab.com)

Large, unheated specimens of Kashmir sapphire displaying an attractive colour, such as shown in Lot 11, are considered rare.



The Gübelin Gemstone Rating

The Gübelin Gemstone Rating assesses the quality, rarity and salience of a specific gemstone and translates these attributes into a simple number: the Gübelin Points. It gives meaningful orientation for privates and for professionals who wish to get a comprehensive ranking for their gemstones. So far, there is no common language to describe the key characteristics to communicate beauty, quality or rarity in a consistent way. The Gübelin Points intend to provide comparability and direction by reducing the complexity inherent to coloured gemstones.

The Gübelin Gemstone Rating procedure assesses different characteristics of the gemstone that contribute to its beauty, the rarity and the attractiveness. The assessed characteristics yield an overall rating on a scale of 75 to 100 Gübelin Points.

Rating aspects

The Gübelin Gemstone Rating comprises three domains: quality, rarity and salience.

Quality is the major part and covers the main visual characteristics of the gemstone, consisting of colour, clarity and transparency as well as cut and brilliance.

Rarity considers the relative availability of this type of gemstone in the market. It includes the gemstone variety, its size and the absence, presence and severity of treatment.

Salience addresses the extent of exceptionality and attractiveness of a gemstone beyond the objective characteristics of the quality category. It is best seen as the gemstone's capability to stick out of the crowd. (Source: gubelingemlab.com)
